When you break down a difficult task into manageable components, you can achieve more. A systematic and realistic approach can make a big difference. Perseverance teaches us not to lose heart.

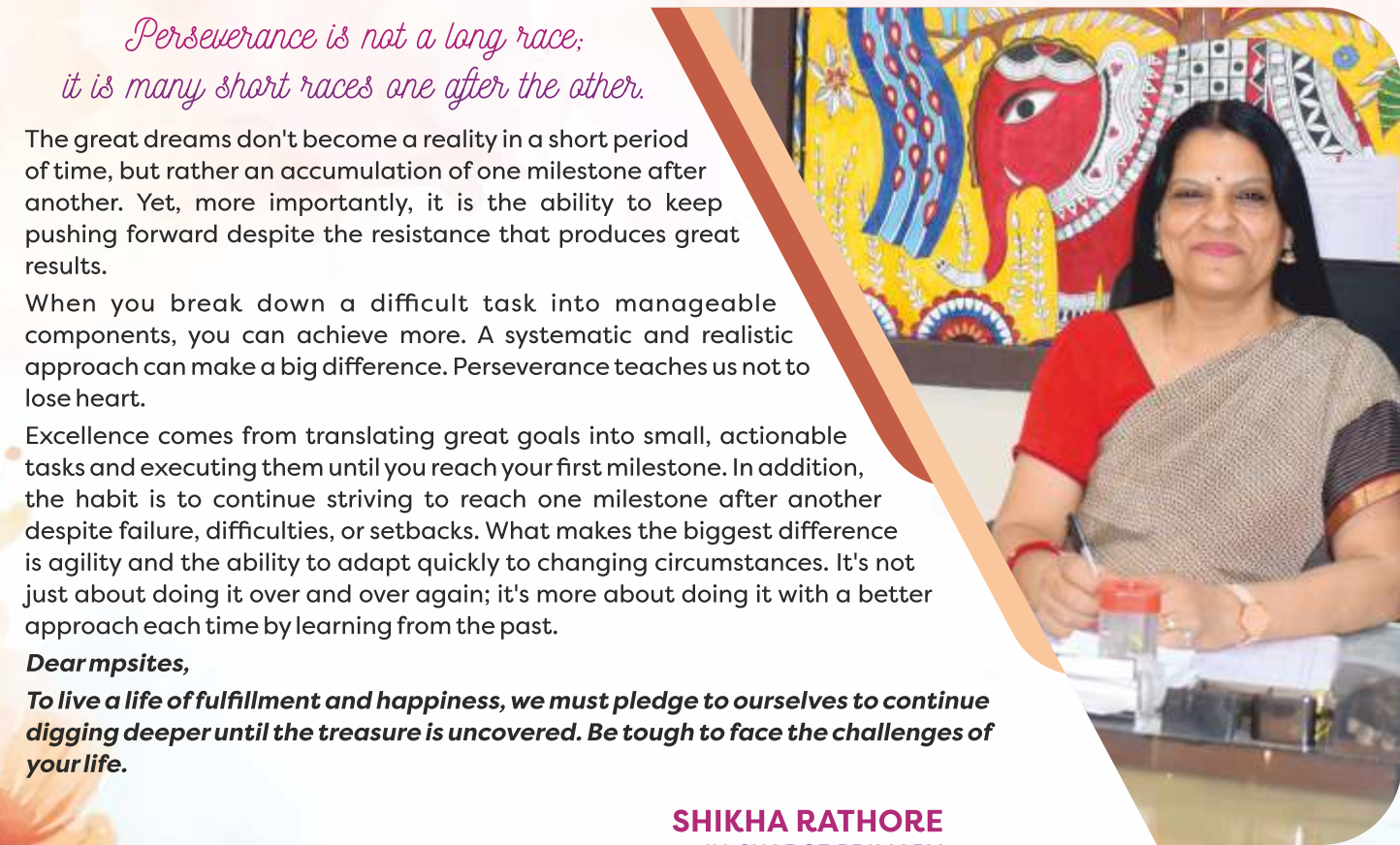
